## SCHOLARSHIP GRANTS CRITERIA USED IN JUDGING APPLICATIONS

Whereas the Grange has always promoted education, citizenship and cooperation, the Grange Services Department will use the following criteria for judging each application:

- 1. The applicant must be a Grange member (minimum 1 year membership).
- 2. Applicant must be enrolled to an accredited post secondary educational institution.
- 3. The application must reflect the importance of education to the applicant.
- 4. Financial need this information is input by the applicant in the appropriate areas of the form.
- 5. The part the applicant has played in Grange work and how they have fulfilled their obligations.

## 6. APPLICATION IS COMPLETE ONLY WITH ALL REQUESTED INFORMATION;

- a. The application form must be completed and signed by the applicant.
- b. A current letter of recommendation from an academic staff member, an employer or manager from the applicant's place of employment, or a member of another community organization.
- c. A letter from a Grange Officer, (non-relative) which provides information on the applicant's involvement in Grange activities. This is not limited to your subordinate grange.
- d. An essay from the applicant with his/her educational goals and financial needs signed by the applicant.
- e. Transcripts of grades from the high school or college last attended. (This is not required if the applicant has been out of school for more than 5 years.)
- 7. The scholarship money will be provided for a future school term and will be assigned to the student and the school the student will be attending.
